**Space Center Houston – Space Camp**

Explore space overnight at the NASA Space Center! Boy Scouts participate in awesome activities. The Camp-in includes building and launching an air pressure rocket, designing and building a Martian base, constructing a space station, exploring our Starship Gallery and seeing real NASA spacecrafts including astronaut capsules that have been to the moon! Scouts will also have an opportunity to earn Space Exploration Merit Badge on the Outing.

We will sleep in the Space Center; so we will be inside. It will be like a giant sleepover at NASA! Scouts will need only a sleeping bag, pillow, toiletries, pajamas (PJs, sweats or shorts/t-shirt are recommended. There are security cameras in the building), and a change of clothing. Scouts will be expected to wear Scout t-shirts and shorts with belt loops. Scout shorts and socks are not required. We will travel in Class A uniform shirts as usual. Bring a light sweatshirt in case you get cool in the air conditioning. The following items are prohibited at NASA: food/snacks, flashlights, radios, portable music players, or other electrical devices. Due to space limitations, cots and air mattresses are allowed only for adults with a medical reason. Sleeping bag mats are permitted.

Special t-shirts and a patch may be available if the Scouts decide to place a bulk order. We will decide after registration.

Although no extra money is needed for the Camp-In, many campers bring spending money for the Space Trader gift shop. A special 10% discount is offered to all campers.
