It is the time of year that we collect the fees to pay our dues to Boy Scouts of America for recharter (one year membership to BSA) and the annual assessment fee. The recharter and magazine fee's are paid directly to Boy Scouts of America, and the assessment fee is to cover our expenses for merit badges, advancement patches, and many other misc items. Anyone not paying the fees will be dropped from BSA membership, this will mean your son can not advance, earn merit badges, or participate in scouting events. **The troop needs to have this collected NO LATER THAN 03/03/2010 to be able to pay our fees to BSA and to help cover the troops expenses.** Anyone after 03/03/2010 will be required to fill out new applications.

Boy Life Magazine is well worth the money, for 1 year you will receive a magazine that has tips and tricks for everything from things to do while traveling to tricks for home work, not to mention some really great articles on camping and what is going on in other areas of the country with regard to Scouting. This is also a point for Quality Unit. We get it as a family and I would recommend it to all. The dues are as follows:

Scout (boy under the age of 18)	\$75.00 (BoysLife is an additional charge.)
Adult Scouter (anyone above 18)	\$25.00 (Scouting magazine is included.)
The cost for the scouting magazines is	\$12.00 New or renewal of subscription

Troop Family cap on cost is 100.00 plus Boy's Life if desired.

Example: Your son and 1 parent/guardian with Boy's Life would be \$112.00 check payable to "Troop 32"

Please make your check payable to "Troop 32" and in the memo line please put "RECHARTER and the name of the scout/s (your son/s), scouters, and boys life (if subscribing).

***** ATTENTION *****

If you are dual registered you do not have to pay dues with Troop32. For example this means you pay the crew for your BSA membership. Please let me know that you are dual registered, we will take care of the rest. BUT I NEED TO KNOW
