

2010 Troop 32 Summer Camp Outing Notice Camp Alexander, CO June 26 – July 3, 2010

ALL registrations MUST be returned by the November 10th Troop Meeting.

The Troop's 2010 Summer Camp will be held at Camp Alexander in Colorado during the week of June 26th to July 3rd. We have reserved a limited number of spots for 40 Scouts and 8 Scouters to attend.

Spots at Camp Alexander Summer Camp will be allocated on a first-come, first-served basis.

Our current plan is to travel by van leaving Keller / IMS Thursday AM, June 24th. We are arranging a White Water River Raft trip, probably on the Arkansas River, for Friday afternoon. Saturday, we will tour either the Air Force Academy or Pikes Peak on the way into Camp Alexander. On our return, we will stop over at the Royal Gorge National Park for several hours. We will have purchased a group rate to allow the scouts to ride the gondola across the gorge, the rail car to the base, walk the bridge (the highest suspension bridge in the world) and eat lunch. The cost for the River Raft Trip and the Royal Gorge adventure is included in the Outing Fee noted below. **All Adults attending camp must be willing stay the entire time at camp and to drive one of the vans to and from the camp.**

Obviously, at this early date, these side trips and rates are subject to change. If one is cancelled, applicable portions will be refunded. There is a slight possibility charges could result in a slight increase in the T-32 outing cost. We have tried very hard to anticipate these actual costs and projected our outing fees accordingly.

Camp Alexander is located in the beautiful Eleven mile Canyon in the Pike National Forest approximately 45 miles west of Colorado Springs, and two miles south of Lake George, in Park County, Colorado. Camp Alexander is between 8200 and 8600 feet elevation. The camp area consists of hills, low mountains, and valleys covered by a mix of Ponderosa pine forests, high-altitude grasslands, and wetland vegetation along the lake and stream. There is abundant wildlife including black bears, raccoons, skunks, rabbits, squirrels, deer, elk, coyotes, snakes, and bald eagles.

The camp is projecting 28 merit badges and will have a listing out Nov 1st. You can imagine the mountain bike, hiking and climbing opportunities in the Rocky Mountains. Merit Badge sign ups will be conducted on April 26th, so have your requests in by the April 13th Troop Meeting!

Adult participation is very much encouraged and adult training opportunities will be available. An exact listing is not available until February 2010. ***However without sufficient adult leadership and participation, our Scouts will not be able to attend.***

Cost for the Camp Alexander Summer Camp will be \$500 per Scout and \$425 per Scouter. A \$100/person deposit will be required by the November 10th Troop meeting to reserve your space at Camp Alexander Summer Camp. Additional fees may be incurred for certain Merit Badges, extra meals, etc. Please consult the website at the above address for any questions.

Refunds will be made only if the Troop is refunded money. We anticipate a slight adjustment to the price – possible up or down - when travel and tour arrangements are finalized. The Troop reserves the right to charge participants for additional unexpected expenses.
